

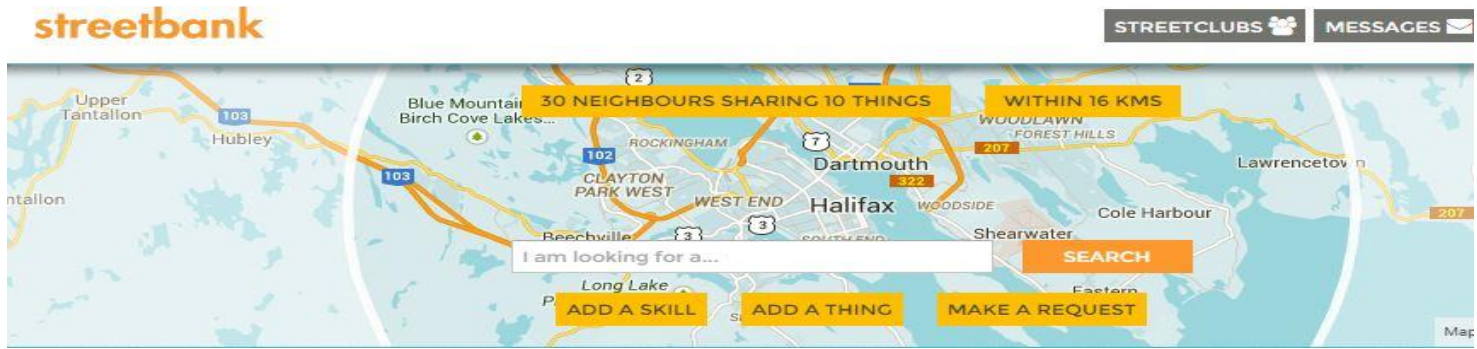

Connecting needs with resources



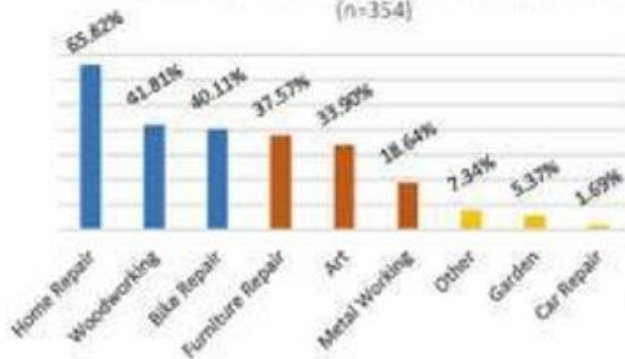


Level of Interest (n=344)

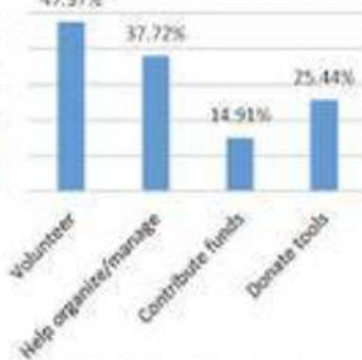


Our Survey Results are in! Here's what you told us...

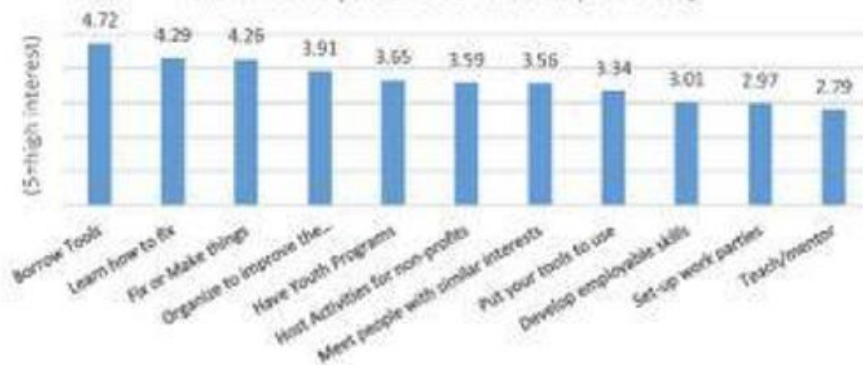
Tool Collections Desired, Percent of Respondents (n=354)
